May 26, 2005. Reported, adversely, to the House. H.Rept. 109-100.

June 7, 2005. H.Res. 304, providing for 2 hours of general debate, and the previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions, and the measure will be considered read, and the bill is closed to amendments, reported to the House, H.Rept. 109-106.

June 8, 2005. H.Res. 304 passed the House by voice vote.

June 9, 2005. Failed passage by a vote of 86 yeas, 338 nays.
